Everlasting Sandcastles

You will need

- 2 Kitchen Roll tubes
- Empty washing liquid up bottles
- Empty plastic pop bottles
- Play sand
- Scissors
- Paintbrush
- Large kitchen tray
- PVA glue

What you do

- 1 Cut one of the kitchen roll tubes in half. Take one of the halves and make snips around one end of the tube, this will be the turret. Fold every other flap forward and cut off these folded flaps.
- 2 Cut a door out of your turret.
- 3 Fill your tray with sand, cover your turret, pop bottle and washing up liquid bottles with the PVA glue. Roll them in the sand until they are completely covered.
- 4 Once dry, put all of your pieces together and you have an everlasting sandcastle!

This can be used as part of a small world beach scene.

* You could add some shells and twigs from the beach to decorate your own everlasting sandcastle.

* Use different shaped bottles, paper plates and lengths of cards to add walls and other parts to your castle.
